

Peer Passenger Exemption Form

This form is designed to assist PI drivers, under the age of 25 years, to comply with peer passenger restrictions.

As a PI driver, it is your responsibility to satisfy Tasmania Police that you meet the relevant exemption criteria each time you get behind the wheel if required. Keep this form on you when driving to provide to police if asked.

This form is not a legal document and does not mean you are automatically exempt from peer passenger restrictions. If police are not satisfied with the level of information provided they may conduct further investigations.
